The year begins with a fresh outlook, whatever events unfold in the world. Early in January, the first author's copy of John's *Fool's New Journey Tarot* appeared, to his great delight: we rarely receive a new book this early in the year! These cards are designed to be read by anyone, even those without any tarot background. John writes more about them below in the *Forthcoming Books* section below.

Getting this newsletter together for this spring has been put back several times by additional items that needed to be added, as well as by the Royal Mail postage rise, which has ensured that this newsletter comes without any updated booklist. We had not quite caught up with the surprise and unannounced postal rise of last October, since it is a huge administrative undertaking at a time when we had more teaching and book production over the winter than would allow us time to catch up. We are very pleased that our expanding Walkers Between the Worlds shamanic training programme opened its first Irish Foundation course this year. In 2025, we will have three Foundation Courses — one in Oxford, one in Ireland and one on the South Coast: all of these lead through to the professional training programme For the present, the Intermediate and Advanced courses will remain based in the UK. We have enough experienced students to open up the higher levels of the training again, thank goodness, so watch this space.

With our January birthdays done, we plunge into further Substack adventures. Last August, when we went to send out the updated newsletter via MailChimp, the sender refused to do any more sending out without a large sum of money. In our researches, we started to look at alternatives and stumbled across Substack – this is an online platform that was started by journalists who'd been laid off over the Covid years. Here writers can do occasional or regular writing which is available free, but whose premium content is reserved for subscribers. We both accordingly went over to it and have found it works very well – especially for those students who would like to study with us but who live overseas. We are able to speak as well as write, and there are already a few meditations and poems available. It also enables our readers and students to support our work in a modest way, which is a great comfort, as we are both in our seventies.




2024 is certainly John's year to have many books emerge, just as 2023 was Caitlín's in terms of books that are appearing.

THE FOOL'S NEW JOURNEY TAROT by John & Charles Newington

In 2020 the world changed. The arrival of a world-wide pandemic ensured it could never be quite the same again. In the same way, facing new issues at every level of life, it is time for tarot to change. The Fool must begin a new journey. Since the origins of Tarot in the 15th century, decks have remained largely unchanged. At the height of the global pandemic, John began to consider if the tarot archetypes were really set in stone. Could the basic meanings and applications of the cards, as well as the whole underlying structure, change? The answer was, yes! It was time for the Fool to journey by previously untrodden paths to being us the answers we sought.

Here we have returned to a new simplicity of imagery, not requiring a knowledge of esoteric symbolism. The images make it immediately understandable to all readers. **The Fool's New Journey Tarot** represents recognizable aspects of the human condition without losing the deeper resonance of the traditional deck. The art, too, is very different from that of earlier times – simpler, more direct and personal than the


Love, Sighs & Reunion from the Magic Lantern Vera Sibilla Cards

Caitlín's **Magic Lantern Vera Sibilla Course**, with new cards by Anastasia Kashian is now going to be published in Spring 2025. This is the first book and deck set in the English language to teach how to read

Vera Sibilla, the Italian small-card oracle which impudently speaks to the unasked question in your head. Similar to Petit Lenormand and Kipper, Vera Sibilla is read very differently, though still in a cartomantic way, whereby the meanings are linguistic rather than visual. The course book enables readers to learn the system over the course of a year by studying and using the cards practically until proficiency is gained. The new cards by Anastasia Kashian – all drawn and painted by hand - will serve new generations of Vera Sibilla users for years to come

Looking ahead, Caitlín has started work on a completely rewritten and updated **Ladies of the Lake** for publication in June 2025. Coming later on is Caitlín's **The One and Only Petit Etteilla Course** which will be available online with the cards made by Rebecca Birrell. This is a complete Petit Etteilla course which comes with a full English translation of Etteilla's *La Seule Manière de Tirer Les Cartes* of 1773. There is no date yet.







Annotated Morte d'Arthur

Among the most exciting projects coming along is **THE VOICE OF MERLIN:** A Chronicle of Forgotten **Prophecies**, Including a First English Translation of *The Prophecies of Merlin* from 1498 by Maarten Haverkamp, Edited by John Matthews. Foreword by R.J. Stewart. Inner Traditions, Spring, 2025. Discovering a hitherto lost or forgotten book about Merlin and King Arthur is a rare event these days. Yet here we present a previously almost unknown and completely untranslated book, which includes much that is new – and exciting – about the legendary king and his magical advisor. It enables us to hear again the authentic voice of Merlin from long ago.

Throughout the Middle Ages a number of volumes were produced said to be the *Prophecies of Merlin*. Most of these prophecies were written retrospectively, and are of little interest. However, within several of these volumes were hidden a series of clues that lead to the heart of the Arthurian mysteries - secrets long hidden behind the obscure language of the prophetic utterances. One volume in particular, entitled *The Prophecies of Merlin*, printed in 1498, preserved much of this early lore, hidden within the collections of prophetic verbiage. John and the translator Martin Haverkamp have unravelled these lost stories and laid them out for all to see and understand. Here you will find the story of Merlin's birth, of his first adventures, his affair with the Lady of the Lake, and much more.

In 2017 Maarten Haverkamp acquired a 15th century incunabula, an early printed book which contained a text originally written in the 13th century and printed in 1498. The *Prophecies of Merlin* purported to be actual prophecies given by the great Arthurian magician who, though fictitious in this later incarnations, was based on a much older historical figure from the 6th or 7th centuries AD. This book s in fact a compilation of several older documents, first collected by an unknown monk living in Venice in the 13th century. In 2118 Haverkamp contacted John and now, five years on, he has completed the first English translation of the book from medieval French, which both he and John Matthews have studied for context and significance and provided a detailed commentary. For students and lovers of Arthurian literature this is a uniquely important manuscript, which adds significantly to our knowledge of the myths and legends of Europe's most popular subject matter. This extraordinary discovery is a must have for everyone interested in the Arthurian stories.

The Annotated Le Morte d'Arthur by Sir Thomas Malory, edited by John Matthews, with annotations by John & the late Greg Stafford, has finally started to activate. We have announced this book many times, but the publishers have lost two editors through death over the last years, and things were held up. This is the first edition of Malory's book to be fully annotated with a parallel text. This makes it a perfect version for all those who want to read Malory's incomparable version of the life, deeds and death of King Arthur, but who may be unfamiliar with the details, characters and traditions of the 15th century text. This is presented in modern spelling and punctuation for further ease of reading. The new edition is designed to look like a medieval book which would have been printed on parchment, and is decorated throughout with the armorial escutcheons of the Round Table knights. From Chaosium, later this year, since proofs have just been received.



John is currently working on *The Sleeping Beauty Oracle*, with art by the fabulous Yvonne Gilbert (forthcoming, Autumn, 2025). More of which next time!

He has also completed *The Sword in the Stone*: A 4000 Year Story Written in the Stars, which studies the worldwide appearance of the Sword in the Stone tradition, from the familiar story of King Arthur proving himself the rightful ruler of Britain. Written in collaboration with Linda Malcor (coauthor, with John, of *Artorius: The Real King Arthur* (Amberley, 2023).

John is finishing a revised, extended and updated edition of *The Camelot Oracle* (Red Feather, 2025), which includes the original art by by Will Worthington, new writing and four new cards designed by Wil Kinghan.

NEW AND REPRINTED BOOKS

Caitlín's **CELTIC DEVOTIONAL**; **DAILY FOR PEOPLE OF SPIRIT** is available once again, as a devotional for all people of any spiritual background, with morning and evening prayer over the four seasons and Celtic Festivals, based upon nature, rather than theology! This much-loved book has been out of print for over 15 years. It returns with completely newly illustrations by Wil Kinghan.

Caitlín's **TAROT MÉDIÉVAL: MYSTERIES OF. THE INTITIATE'S PATH** originally published in 1939 by Francis Rolt Wheeler and Christian Loring, this tarot barely saw the light of day before the fall of France removed it from the face of the earth: Caitlín has translated and edited the text, with additions, while Wil Kinghan has restored the images. Francis Rolt Wheeler edited the esoteric magazine *L'Astrosophie* from 1929-1958. *Tarot Médiéval* is an esoteric tarot, based in the school of Oswald Wirth: it sees the tarot as an unfolding of the initiate's path in a medieval context. The art is very romantic, redolent of the quest.


Caitlín's THE TIME CHANGER'S TAROT, Reading for Yourself, Your Community and Your World With an accompanying small version of the Waite-Smith Tarot, the book concentrates upon how we use our tarot in a more accountable way, including our environment and the strange times through which we are living, when nothing can be relied upon to remain unchanged. By pro-actively working with the world in and out of time, we ourselves become the time-changers of the title, able to navigate a way between the unknown shoals before us for ourselves, our community and issues affecting the whole world. Each card meaning offers a variety of possibilities, depending on what we are reading for.





Celtic Devotional, Tarot Medieval, and Time-Changers Tarot

John's beautiful **THE GREAT BOOK OF KING ARTHUR** is a continuation of Malory's *Morte D'Arthur*, telling the stories that Malory left out – all drawn from texts that he couldn't have had recourse to. The book is illustrated by John Howe (of *Lord of the Rings* fame), and has a foreword by Neil Gaiman. Most stories will be unfamiliar. If you want to find out what happened to Arthur after he was taken to Avalon at the end of his life, that story is retold here. Many others, featuring favourite knights such as Gawain, Lancelot, and Perceval, along with less well-known characters such as Sone de Nansay, Sir Marrok, and the female knight, Avenable. The text is splendidly designed with rubrics for headings, and is full of colour, as well as black and white images, making this a book to rejoice in.

ARTORIUS: THE REAL KING ARTHUR John with Linda Malcor. The search for the historical figure behind what is arguably the most famous cycle of legends ever has been relentless over the centuries. In this book we argue that the man whose story started the traditions of Arthur was a soldier name Lucius Artorius Castus who lived at the end of the second century A.D. Artorius' extraordinary career took him from one end of the Roman Empire to the other, bringing him into contact with tribespeople amongst the Steppe nomads – in particular the Sarmatians. For several decades the Sarmatians have been thought to be the inspiration behind Arthur's Knights of the Round Table, among other British tales. We focus on Castus's career, not only commenting on the parallels with the Arthurian tradition but also providing details about the Roman Empire of the second century A.D.







CELTIC BOOK OF THE DEAD by Caitlín and Danuta Mayer. This 42-card oracle is based on the ancient 8th century Irish story of the *Voyage of Maelduin*, given here in a new translation by Caitlín Matthews. The locations of Maelduin's voyage form the route toward the Blessed Isles that lie west of Ireland; for him, and for the reader, each island reveals the wonders and challenges as he sails nearer to the heart of the Celtic Otherworld. As with the *Egyptian Book of the Dead*, this oracle gives the soul opportunities to purify, clarify, and refocus. Filled with wonders, terrors, and transformational experiences, each island represents a staging post on the reader's own voyage to self-discovery. As the islands reveal gifts that can be resources for the human condition, so too, solutions and strategies for unknotting life's tangles may be found. The cards have three uses: to divine the path ahead as a guide to

the soul's direction, as a way of meditation for personal and environmental healing, and as a Book of the Dead for the dying. This oracle offers a grown-up method of divination and meditation, based on an ancient north-western European tradition.

SEASONAL SHRINE

THE THINGS WE TAKE WITH US

Over the last summer, we have seen how whole cities and regions have been obliterated by wildfires that burnt houses, public buildings and farms to the ground in a matter of moments. The people who fled from these fires took with them their families and pets, their carriable documents and precious things – if they were quick or forethoughtful enough - and they left behind everything they owned behind. In the autumn, it was the floods that came and inundated – often places that had been previously flooded the year or so before. While the waters subside, things cannot be the same as they were. It is not only natural disasters that play out here, but also the economy of our cruel times, whereby those unable to pay their rent or mortgage have had to move at a few days' notice and resettle in more modest dwellings, or else have become homeless.

Last year, we finalized our wills for the circumstances we are now in – we are older than when we made our last will, 36 years ago, when our son was small – and many things had changed. We both know we cannot take anything with us, and we have made provision for some of our things to be curated or passed on. A friend of mine recently did the Swedish death cleansing because she was leaving her country and moving to a new one: not wanting to leave anything behind for an indifferent family to deal with, she got rid of everything except what she could carry. The courage in clearing the way for this utter break and new beginning at the end of her life is remarkable and very chastening. We spend a lifetime acquiring and in one stroke, death severs us from everything. We cannot tell what will removed from us by uncertain fate or fortune, indeed.

23 years ago, when I was invited to speak in Israel by the Israeli publisher and translator of my *Singing The Soul Back Home* book, I found myself teaching a foundation course in shamanism at Neve Shalom, the Peace Village near Tel Aviv. Most of my students were 2-4th generation Israelis, but all were from a huge diaspora who have come back to the Middle East after wondering in Russia, Argentina, South Africa, North America, and many other lands. We talked about that return and what it had meant to their families – some of whose ancestors had arrived in Tel Aviv before any jetty was built, so they literally leapt into the water and use their suitcase as a flotation device to reach the shore. But I was interested in a question of, 'Just as your ancestors always had a little bag ready to go, against the

inevitable next persecution that drove them out of their places, what is in your little bag, ready to go? – What is it that you need to take with you now?'

This was a question that could have been answered on many levels. Some students were alarmed at the thought of yet another migration, while others understood that the question was coming from a place of ancestral preparedness. Very interesting answers resulted: it seemed that ancestral providence came very readily to the surface, for Jews are hard-wired for this question, and how you manage yourself and your community when the whole i. Although a couple of students; families still had the keys to houses from which their ancestors had been expelled back in 1492 Spain, while others had inherited menorahs or sacred books borne away from pogroms in Krakow or Breslov, the things that my students need to take with them 20 years ago were more than just objects, but also memories, teachings, wisdom.

In our own straightened times where the economy and the relentless urging to boost growth results in that everyone becomes much poorer; when the uncertainties of climate, work, zones of conflict and new persecutions drive migrants further afield; when the things we have or expect to have are constrained, removed, lost or never even gained; when infrastructure break down, when the safety-net has been removed, or you are exiled from all that you know, what is it that you need to take with you now?



When faced with this question myself, I recall the time when Socrates was walking in the countryside with his friend, Phaedrus: they sat down in a beautiful spot and Socrates burst out into spontaneous prayer to the gods of that place: 'O beloved Pan, and all ye other Gods, who are residents of this place, grant that I may become beautiful within, and that whatever I possess externally may be friendly to my inward attainments! Grant also, that I may consider the wise man as one who abounds in wealth and that I may enjoy that portion of gold, which no other than a prudent man is able either to bear, or properly manage.' (*Phaedrus*, 279)

It is the blessing of all wise ones is to know what is good for us, and if we do not, to hold our possessions lightly.
